Material staging works great for contractors that need warehouse space for lighting, switchgear, electrical and data cabinets and other large items.

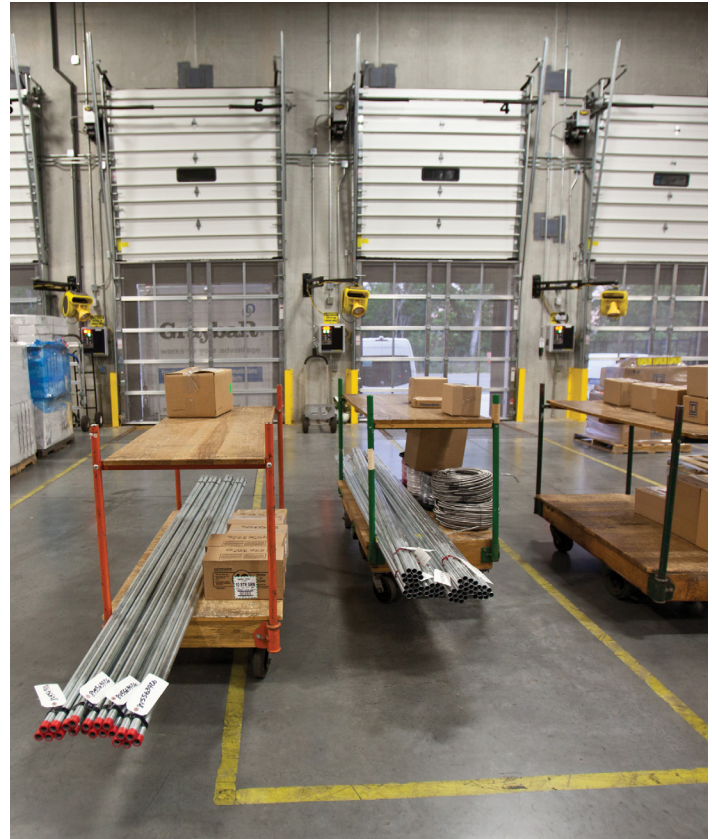
Industrial
